## Mad Fish /PAL Fishing Tournament

June 19th, 20th, and 21st Falmouth, Massachusetts

### TOURNAMENT RULES

1. The Captain's Meeting is required and will be held on June 19<sup>th</sup>, at the Police Athletic League.
2. IGFA rules. Official tournament time is local GPS time.
3. June 20th - First Day Fishing - lines in 12:01 AM.  
June 21st - Second Day Fishing - lines out at 3:00 PM.
4. All fish must be designated before weighing and must be weighed at the official weigh station in Falmouth Harbor.
5. The weigh station will be open each day from 5:30 PM - 7:00 PM. Fish caught on Friday, June 20th, may be weighed at the weigh station on Friday (June 20th) or retained and weighed on Saturday (June 21st).
6. All boats must be in position to weigh fish no later than 7:00 PM on Saturday, June 21st. (No Exceptions)
7. The Tournament Channel will be announced at the Captain's meeting.
8. There is no weather committee. The decision to fish is left solely to participants who do so at their own risk.
9. The decision to return to port on Friday evening, June 20th, is left solely to participants.
10. Any protests must be made in writing and presented to the Tournament Committee by 7:00 PM each day.
11. There is no limit to the number of fishing rods.
12. All fish weighed in for prize consideration must be caught from a registered boat or must be a registered shore angler. Only in the event of a mechanical failure may participants fish from another vessel. The Tournament Committee must be advised in writing prior to a vessel change.
13. All fish are the boat's property.
14. All decisions regarding any and all issues made by the Tournament Committee are final. There are no refunds.
15. Sportsmen like conduct ashore and afloat is expected of all participants and their guests.

We understand that this release includes any claims based on any negligent act or negligent omission of the Corporation.
